- ❖ Must currently be an intern at a BEDC member company.
- ❖ Resident of San Diego.

Scholarship Application Criteria

- ❖ Must complete application.
- ❖ Write an essay of 300-350 words which highlights the impact an internship at a biotech company would have on your career direction. Talk about why you have chosen science as a career. Describe people and situations which have impacted you. Be creative and open. Relate how this scholarship will assist you in furthering your education at the college/university level.
- ❖ Include the most current official transcript from high school/college. If you have completed less than one full year of post secondary school, high school transcript must be included.
- ❖ Letters of recommendation from mentor of your internship and from a community person.
- ❖ Verification of residency.
- ❖ Applications must be postmarked by August 28, 2009.
- ❖ Recipients will be announced in the beginning of September 2009.

Scholarship Size

- ❖ Scholarships will range from \$1,000 - \$10,000.
